







PURPOSE OF POST





Your work will focus on delivering youth clubs, running holiday programmes, and engaging with local schools. The role is designed to help young people develop life skills, build their confidence, and connect with their community.







RESPONSIBILITIES

Youth Engagement: Facilitate engaging and meaningful programmes for children and young people at the community centre and in local schools.

Event Delivery: Lead our youth clubs, coordinate school holiday activities, and support the Youth Board.

Mentorship: Provide guidance and support to young people, helping them navigate challenges and work towards their goals.

Community Connection: Work alongside families, schools, and other local organizations to create a cohesive, supportive network for youth.

Inclusion & Safety: Ensure that all activities are inclusive, welcoming, and safe for all participants.


